16. Vase of any other Spring Flower

SECTION 4- DOMESTIC CLASS

33. Lemon Drizzle Cake. Recipe provided.

INGREDIENTS:

100g (3 ½ g) soft margarine

175g (6oz) self-raising flour

1tsp baking powder

175g (6oz) caster sugar

2 eggs

4 tbsp milk

Finely grated rind of one lemon

For the topping: Juice of 1 lemon

100g (3 ½ oz) granulated sugar

METHOD:

1. Lightly grease and line a 2lb loaf tin (or use a paper liner).
2. Pre-heat oven to 180/Fan 170
3. Put all cake ingredients into a large bowl (or food processor) and beat well for about 2 minutes.
4. Pour into the lined tin and bake for approx 35 minutes or until the cake springs back when pressed.
5. While the cake is baking make the topping by just stirring the 2 topping ingredients together.
6. Spoon the lemon topping over the baked cake whilst it is still hot, then leave to cool completely in the tin.

Spring Show Rules

All entries can be accepted on the morning of the Show, but pre-entries are very welcome.

Entry cards can be collected from the trading shed on any Saturday at opening times or send details, via phone or email to the show committee member, details below.

- 1. Exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor for at least 3 months prior to the Show.**
- 2. Exhibits must be staged between 9.00 - 10.30am on the day of the show. No entry allowed during the judging.**
- 3. There is NO FEE to enter.**
- 4. Points awarded as follows: 1st 5pts; 2nd 3pts; 3rd 2pts; H.C. 1pt.**
- 5. No exhibits may be removed until the end of the Show.**
- 6. The Committee does not hold itself responsible for the loss or damage to any exhibit although every care will be taken.**
- 7. Judging will be conducted under RHS Rules. Prizes awarded at the discretion of the Judges/Committee.**
- 8. Children's entries must be their own efforts.**
- 9. Society vases and containers must be used (available in hall kitchen)**
- 10. One entry per exhibitor per class, but multiple entries from the same household are allowed.**
